Final preparations are being made for the Spring Drama Production. Please don't panic if you have children in both drama classes, because we are trying to organize some nursery, but please be prepared. We need parents for noise and crowd control.

Please be aware that you will be asked to provide costuming for your child. We will not be asking for anything difficult, or unattainable, so don't panic! A sketch and detailed description will come home with your student. Please look for it.

And last, but not least, parents we ask that you somehow put line memorization into your daily plans. Some of the senior drama students will have an extensive amount of lines to memorize, so it will be of vital importance that they are prepared. Dress rehearsals are only designed to finalize and correct small glitches in the performance, they are not intended to be used as line rehearsal. We know that every family in co-op has busy schedules, but learning lines is as important as music pieces or math problems. So, please we ask that you support your student in this and be flexible. One of the benefits of homeschooling is the flexibility it gives us. We could perhaps catch up on the math problems after showtime!
